

To all Christianville Supporters:

We the board are writing to inform you of our goals and plans for rebuilding Christianville since the devastating earthquake of Jan12, 2010. The event caused massive loss or severe damage to most of the buildings on our grounds. Our schools will reopen when the Haitian government allows them to reopen. Our partners in ministry, Haiti Health Ministries and Fellowship Of Christian Optometrist, have reopen their clinics in temporary quarters.

We have successfully sent in large tents to be used for temporary classrooms for our kindergarten through twelfth grade classes. This will allow our 1200 students in our schools to proceed with their Christian education and to continue to feed on a daily basis.

We have decided that our rebuilding program will be focused on rebuilding classrooms for our kindergarten through the twelfth grades. We have granted permission to our partners in ministry Haiti Health Ministries and Fellowship Of Christian Optometrists to rebuild facilities on our grounds.

We regret that we have found it necessary not to reopen the Christianville College. We have retained the Charter and the name of the college in the event we can reopen the college in the future when we have accomplished our primary goal of rebuilding our schools.

It is estimated that we will need at least one million dollars to accomplish our goal of rebuilding our school buildings with very modest buildings. To date we have raised just over 300,000 dollars.
